2.1 Membership Fee: Annual	\$150	An ESMA (Eastern Suburbs Montessori Association) membership fee of \$150 per family is payable upon acceptance of a place. Subsequent to the year of enrolment the membership fee is payable annually with Term 1 invoice.
2.2 Placement Fee	\$1,990	A non-refundable placement fee required on enrolment to confirm acceptance of the place.

3.1 Tuition Fees: Per Term (4 terms per year)	\$4,870.00	Tuition Fees are due at the end of the first week of each term.

Notice period required		The school requires one full term's notice in writing before the withdrawal of a student or one full term's Tuition Fees will be charged.
